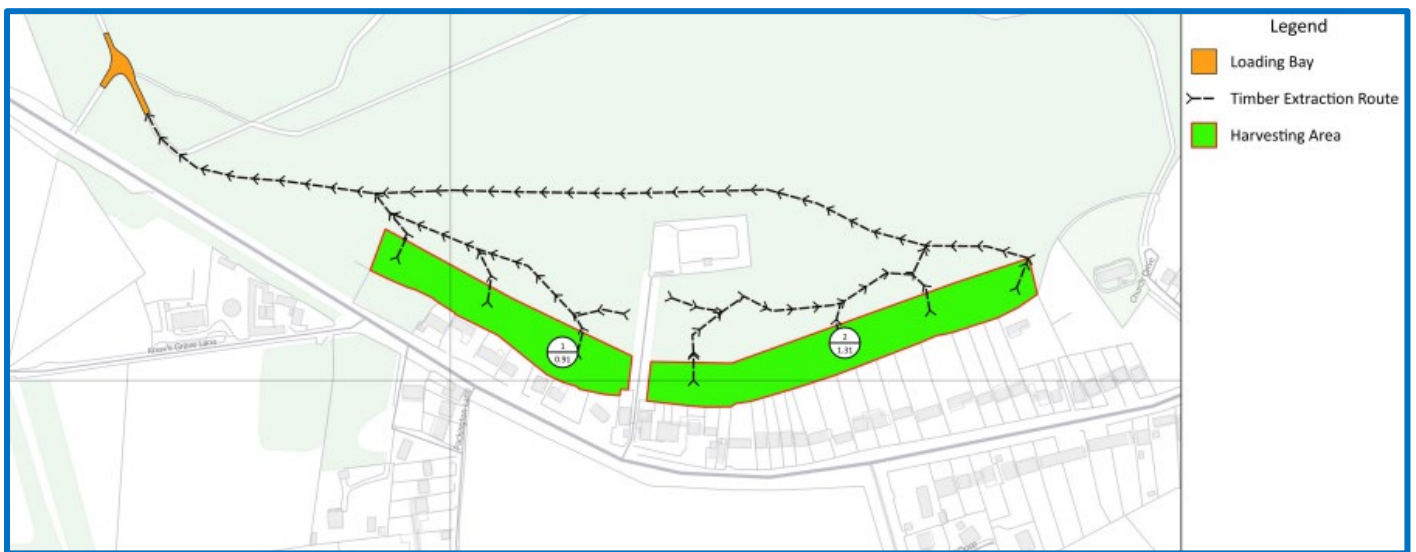


# Notice of forestry works at Hopwas Wood, Tamworth B78 3AL

## What is happening?

- In accordance with a Forestry Commission approved felling licence, timber harvesting is taking place along the on perimeter of Hopwas woods, specifically adjoining the residential properties off Hopwas Hill Road. Trees to be removed include scots pine, larch, and Corsican pine predominantly. These works will reduce the risk associated with falling trees, which have the potential to impact adjoining properties.
- Only a small part of Hopwas woods is affected by this project.
- On completion of the harvesting the felled area will be replanted with native broadleaved trees and mixed woody shrubs.
- The works are only on Tarmac land and are not linked to the MOD ownership of Hopwas Woods. The MOD are aware of the project.



## How long are the works taking?

- The harvesting works will start in November 2025 and are expected to take up to 8-10 weeks to complete, subject to the weather and ground conditions.

## Access and Safety

- Improvements have been made to the existing woodland entrance off Hopwas Hill Road to enable the harvested timber to be safely removed from the site.
- The public right of way will remain open for the duration of the operation.
- During the works, please follow on site signage and do not enter the timber harvesting areas.

## What is *not* happening?

- The proposed works are not linked to any form of mineral activity or extraction.
